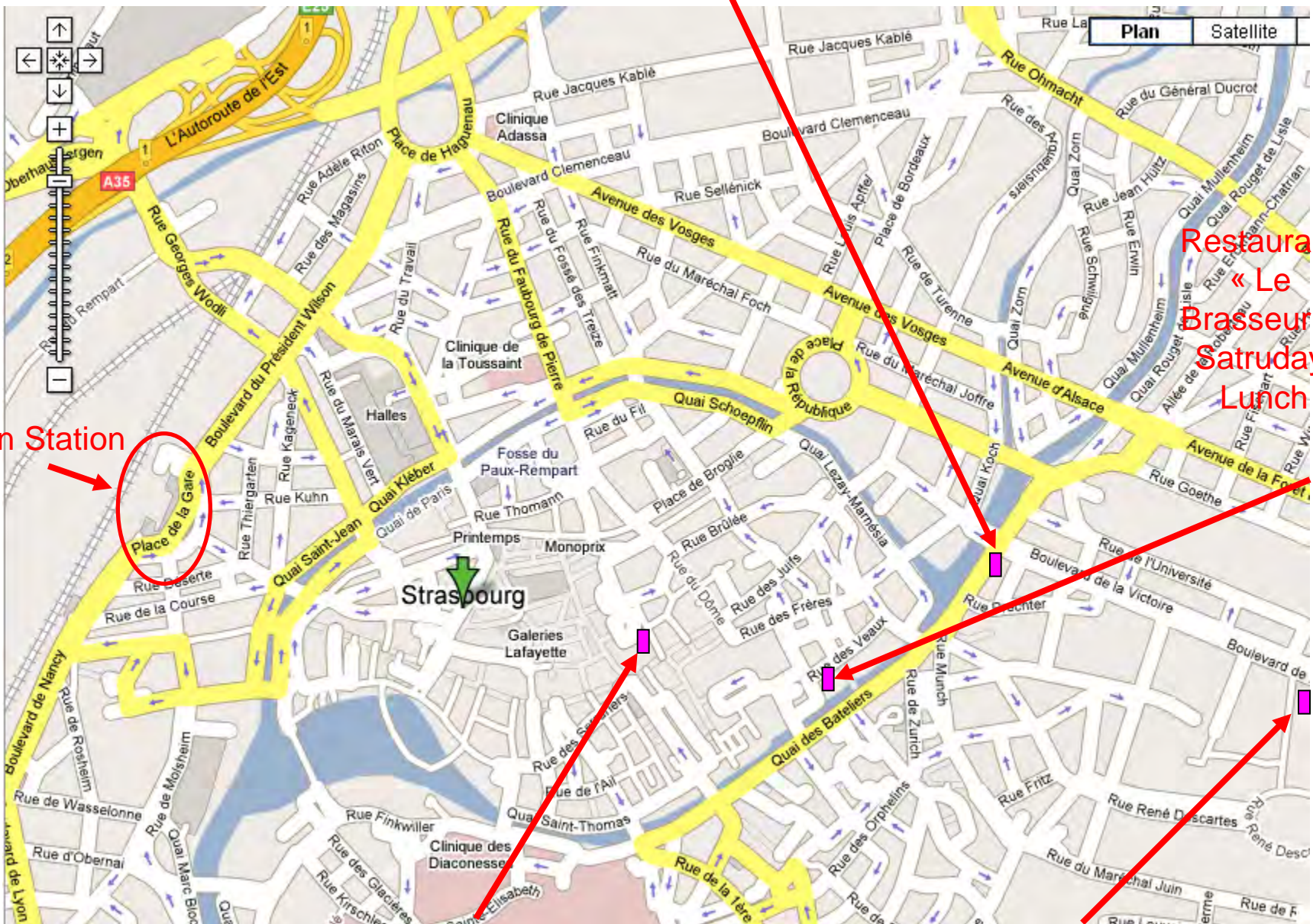

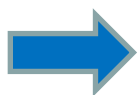

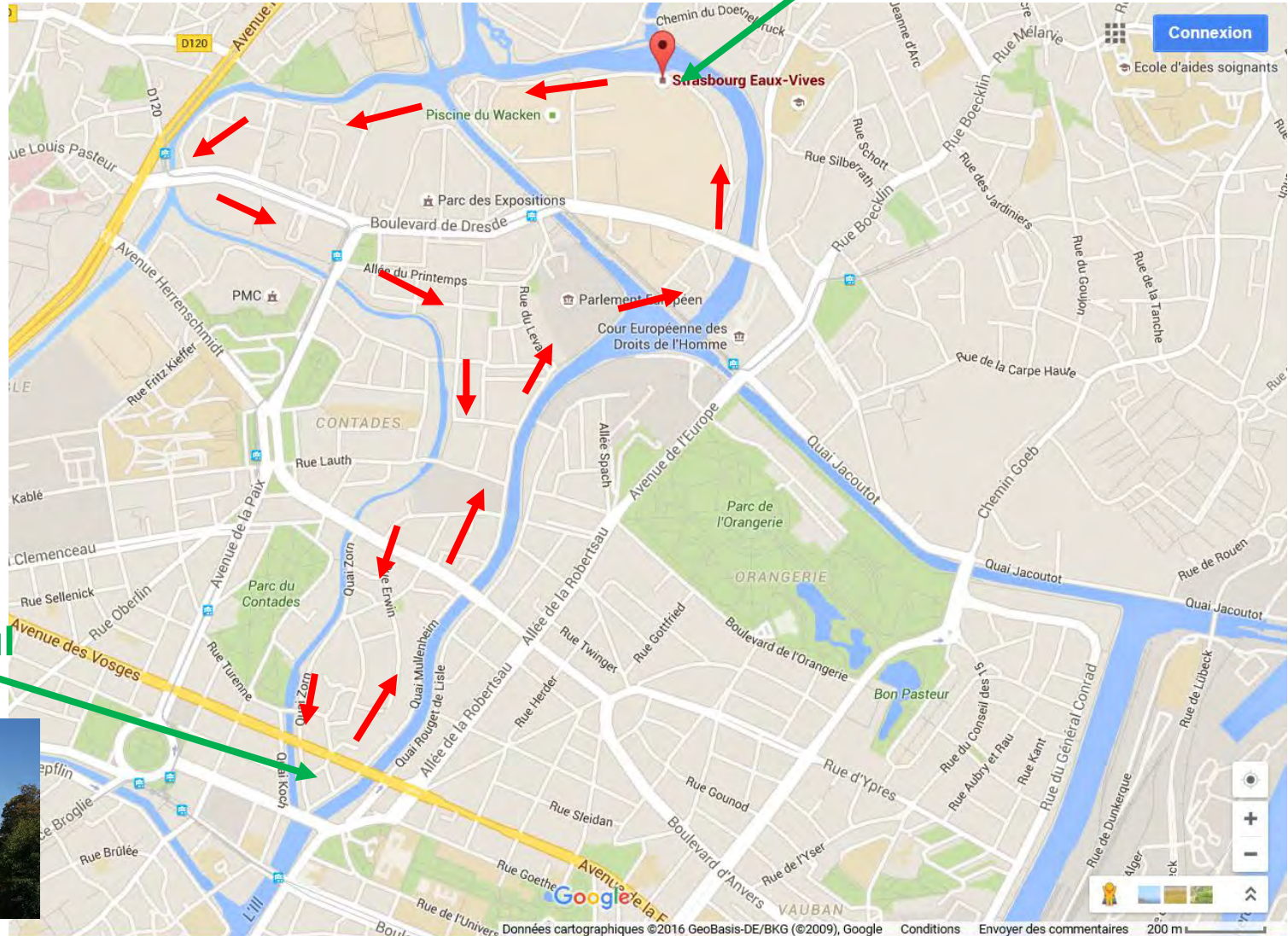


We can not stop either in Wantzenau or in Gambenheim because the level of water is too high (risk to arrive in Rhin river and then ... after many days in Netherlands)

**TRIP 1: Strasbourg – Tour de l’Aar**

**Duration (no transport): 2h30 – 3h**

**Distance: 7km**

**2 portage**

**Effort: easy/average**

**Price: 20 € per person**

Navigation in Strasbourg

Tour de l'Aar: Nature in the city!

Loop course that makes you go up the Aar river (low current) and descent over the Ill river until the arrival which is the departure. You will approach closer to the common wildlife of our rivers. Exotic, even for inhabitants of Strasbourg.

# TRAM map

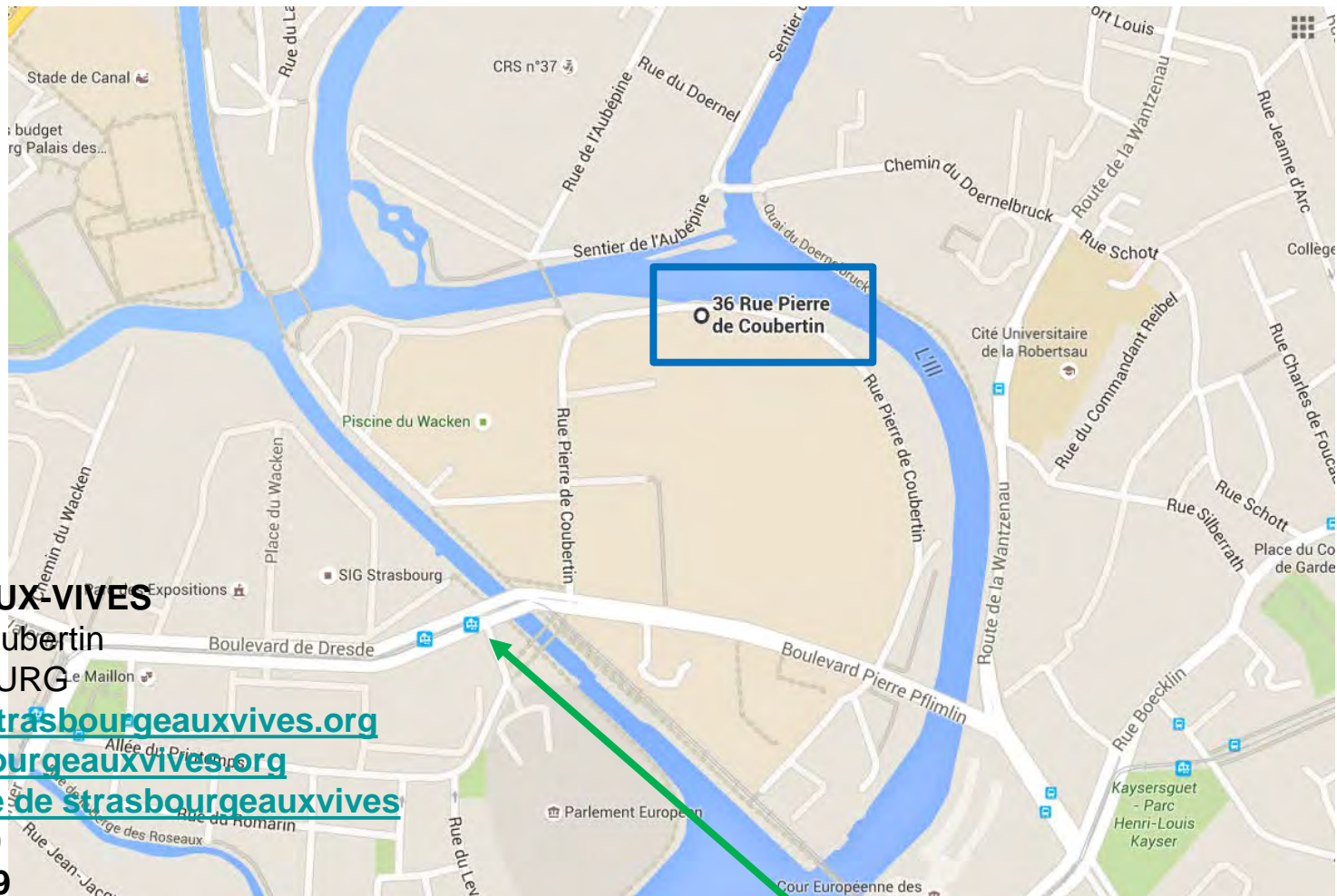
